

COOKIES POLICY

We use cookies to improve the efficiency and offer the User increasingly better functionalities of the website www.topsilglobal.com (hereinafter referred to as the Website) and content more tailored to the User. In order to ensure transparency of activities, this Cookie Policy has been adopted, which sets out detailed rules of use via the Website from cookies.

Data using cookies is collected by TOPSIL Global Sp. z o. o. Sp. komandytowa, ul. Fabryczna 78, 96-100 Skierniewice, Poland, NIP: 8361856206 and TOPSIL Sp. z o. o. Sp. komandytowa, ul. Henryka II Pobożnego 18 02-496 Warszawa, Poland, NIP: 5220005120. If it is determined that the data contained in cookies are personal data, TOPSIL is considered as the Data Administrator, and the User has all the rights specified in the Privacy Policy.

The User is any data subject using our Website and other websites, communications and services related to it (hereinafter referred to as the User).

COOKIES

Cookies are pieces of code that are text files corresponding to HTTP requests to our server. These files are saved by each browser from which the User visits our Website. Thanks to the information contained in cookies, we know how Users use our Website.

Cookies are used by us to ensure optimal service of the User's visit to the Website and enable faster and easier access to information, as well as to offer the User increasingly improved functionalities of the Website and content more tailored to the User.

The stored information or access to it does not cause any configuration changes in the User's device and the software installed on it.

Information contained in cookies is considered personal data only in connection with other personal data available about a given User. We use cookies to collect only anonymous, useful data about the User to the convenience of using the portal and minimizing the nuisance of advertising.

TYPES AND PURPOSES OF USING COOKIES

We use cookies and other similar technologies to recognize the User during his visits to our Website, remember his preferences and display appropriate, tailored content. Cookies make your interactions with us faster and more effective. In addition, cookies enable us to present content tailored to the User without the need to conduct surveys.

The Website uses two types of cookies:

Session cookies - these are temporary files that remain on the User's device until he or she leaves the Website or turn off your web browser. In this case, the information stored in session cookies is automatically deleted.

Persistent cookies - these are files that remain on the User's device for the period specified in the cookie parameters or until they are manually deleted.

The Website also uses other available technologies that allow information to be saved in the browser in appropriate data stores (Session Storage, Local Storage), and are also placed in code fragments of analytical tools provided by other suppliers, which enable cookies to be saved in the domains of these services.

The individual categories of cookies used on our Website are described below:

Technical cookies – they are necessary for the Website to function properly. They relate to the functionality of our websites and enable us to improve the services we offer through our websites, for example by enabling information to be transferred between pages of our website to avoid you having to re-enter information, or by recognizing your preferences when you return to our website. Service.

We use them to:

- ensuring safety;
- maintain a session when you visit and log in to your customer account;
- ensuring proper display of the website - depending on the device the User uses;
- adapting our services to the User's choices;
- remembering whether the User consents to the display of certain content.

Analytical cookies - they allow us to recognize and count the number of Users visiting our Website, see how visitors move around the Website, when they use it, and record which content they view and are interested in. This helps us determine how often pages and advertisements are visited and which areas of our Service are the most popular. This allows us to improve the services we offer,

ensuring that our Users find the information they are looking for. They are also necessary to settle accounts with our Trusted Partners and measure the effectiveness of our marketing activities without identifying personal data.

We use them to:

- researching website traffic statistics and checking the traffic source (redirection directions);
- detecting various types of abuse, e.g. artificial Internet traffic (bots), ddos attacks;
- limiting undesirable marketing activities;
- measuring the effectiveness of marketing campaigns conducted for the Website, e.g. in the Google advertising network,
- in affiliate programs, on external websites;
- settlement with Trusted Partners for advertising services based on user activity, e.g. clicks.

Marketing cookies - are used when the User consents and only when the functionalities and forms of advertising used by our Website require it.

We use them to:

- Displaying advertisements that are relevant and interesting to a specific user; They concern profiling of advertisements displayed both on external websites and on our Website, as appropriate to users' preferences regarding the selection of goods, based on data held by the Website, including user behavior on the Website.
- By accessing the Website, the User may not agree to the use of analytical cookies
- and marketing. Then we will not be able to keep detailed statistics and adapt our advertisements
- based on information collected on our Website. However, general advertisements will still be displayed both on the Website and on other websites.
- To broadcast advertisements on the Internet, as well as other tools such as Google reCAPTCHA (protection tool
- against spam), we use technologies provided by Google and Meta (Facebook), so please note
- whether you consent to the use of these tools, including advertising profiling on the Internet and on Facebook. You can check and manage your privacy and security settings in your Google Account by visiting [g.co/privacytools](https://www.google.com/privacytools).

DISABLING COOKIES

Internet browsers allow the storage of cookies by default. If the User does not want to receive cookies, he or she may change the browser settings on the computer or other device he or she uses to access our Website. The User's continued use of our Website without changing the settings means that the User agrees to receive technical cookies on our Website, which, as we have indicated, are necessary for the proper functioning of the Website.

Most web browsers have a function that allows the User to view and delete cookies, including cookies on our website. However, it should be emphasized that the inability to save or read cookies through the website of our Website may prevent full and correct use of our Website.

If the User uses different devices to access and browse our Website (e.g. computer, smartphone, tablet), he should make sure that each browser on each device is adapted to the preferences related to with cookies.

The method of disabling cookies depends on the browser the User uses. Below is the method in which the User can disable cookies in the Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Opera and Internet Explorer browsers.

Disabling cookies in the Google Chrome browser:

- In the upper right corner of the address bar of Google Chrome, select the three vertical dots.
- In the Privacy Security section, click the Content button.
- In the Cookies and site data section you can change the following cookie settings:
 - Block all cookies
 - Block third-party cookies

Disabling cookies in Firefox:

- In the upper right corner of the Firefox browser window, click Open menu (three horizontal lines) and select Settings.
- Then, from the Privacy and security section, select the cookies and website data tab.
- Select the appropriate security level or configure your own by selecting which elements and scripts to block cookies:
 - All from external sites
 - All
